On Sunday, June 4th, a Doggie Roast, hosted by the Worship

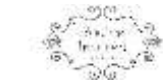


Committee, will be held after worship. Please join us and bring your favorite covered dish to share. Hot dogs, beverages and desserts will be provided.

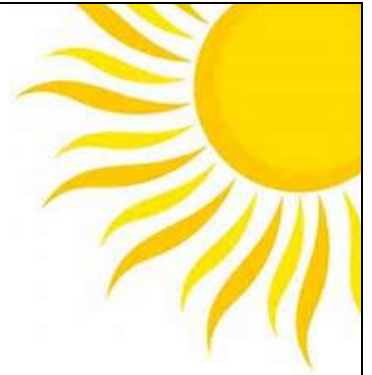
My Earthly Dad
