One of the groups in which I have been participating since I started working with the church is the Slate Belt Ministerium. The Ministerium meets monthly and represents Clergy and church representatives from a host of churches this side of the mountain from Portland to Wind Gap. Rev David Goss of East Bangor Methodist does a great job as our moderator. For the past year we have been meeting over Zoom but we will probably resume our breakfast gatherings in a few months.

The Ministerium invites leaders of various helping groups in the area to share their visions with us (Families First, Slater Family network, Salvation Army, Habitat for Humanity, Rehab centers, etc.). During the pandemic, we have been sharing with each other what our churches are doing and what has been working well or not so well. Almost all of us have been forced to deal with on- line worship services. It has been challenging but it has also forced us into some innovative ways of reaching out to our church members and friends. Some churches are finding this time to present great opportunities to connect with a host of people who normally would not attend the church in- person.

One of the things that I have amazed to learn is the large numbers of food pantries in our area. At this end of the Slate Belt, we are very familiar with PUMP which operates out of Portland and is supported by our congregation. But there are several churches that sponsor their own food banks. Some are small churches such as the Flicksville U.C.C. as well as others in some rural areas like Benders Mennonite, and the Bible Fellowship at Three- Church Hill outside of Martins Creek. Of course, the towns of Bangor, Pen Argyle and Wind Gap are all represented with food ministries sponsored by churches.

Churches and clergy each are asked to make a modest yearly contribution to the Ministerium Relief Fund which is used primarily to help families in need of rent or heating assistance. Our church has been a supporter of the Ministerium.

Looking at the calendar: Please mark Sunday, June 6<sup>th</sup> as a day for celebrating our three graduates, with a brunch to follow. The summer worship schedule (9:30!) begins on the following Sunday. Also, the memorial service for Shirley Sharpe will be held on Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup>, 10 am in our sanctuary. I hope a good number of us can make that service since Shirley was such a regular participant of our ministries.


