Looking Ahead...



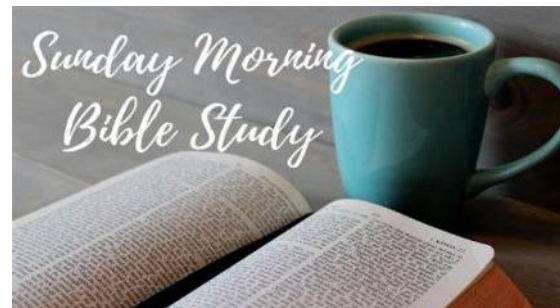
