Here are a few thoughts as we begin the fall regular schedule.

With our projector, screen, new mic and separate camera, the interaction in the class works amazingly well. Last year we usually had four in-person and four on zoom. Our study this fall and possibly into the new year will focus on the Patriarchs (Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, & Joseph), Genesis 12 - 50. We love to have new people join us or even one- time guests.

In November, if possible, we will run the two <u>Soup and Study</u> sessions that were canceled back in March 2020. The theme is: *Dreams*, *Biblical and Yours*. Tentative dates- 11/10 and 11/17.

<u>Fellowship</u>- The deacons will continue to organize coffee times after the service. The next one is on Sunday, September 12th. If there is one thing the pandemic showed us, it is that our times of gathering for fellowship and support are something to cherish and not take for granted.


