As we approach the end of this calendar year, I am mindful of the many blessings we enjoy as a congregation. However, I do have a concern that needs to be shared with you. For several years prior to 2020, we were able to put some funds in reserve left over from the year- end finances. Last year, with the disruptions due to Covid, we ran a deficit and used some of those reserves to balance our expenses.

At the recent November's session meeting it became clear that we are going to face a significant deficit in our church finances for the year 2021, perhaps \$10,000. Since we have these reserves from recent previous years, we are not in crises yet. However, it should also be clear that we need to seek ways to enlarge our financial contributions for the future.

The deficit over the last two years can be traced to a couple of things: The lower worship attendance since March, 2020 is an obvious cause because many people only contribute when they come to church. Our worship attendance has gradually been increasing but it is not at the level of March 2020 and it will be some time before that level returns.

Another reason for the decline is the fact that several of our active people have died in the past year(s). Some others have either moved or their financial situation is uncertain. Also, we may have lost some contributors.

It has been a few years since we have said anything about church finances. I am sharing this information with you now to let you know that your contributions to the congregation are needed and very important to the church's ministry.

Throughout December, we are celebrating the Advent season with the nicely decorated sanctuary, poinsettias, advent wreath and special music. The Deacons are preparing the Advent Luncheon on Sunday, December 5th after the worship service. I am looking forward to our traditional Christmas Eve service starting at 9:30. The deacons will offer hot chocolate to those able to come early for the service. Please note the arrangements for these events elsewhere in the newsletter.

The Sunday morning Bible study on the Old Testament Patriarchs will continue each week at 9:15 except for the 26th.

May we all seek the Lord's blessing for our church and for each other during the busy days ahead.


